

A superpower that transforms the world

We live in a world where every day we hear news about negative things such as conflicts, diseases and inequalities, situations that affect our well-being. In the midst of all this, we firmly believe that heroes ready to fight for justice are needed, to recover the good customs that have recently been lost.

Magnus Scheving is living proof that heroes are real: he thought it was time to create a "win-win" idea to solve a health problem that was experienced in the country and may be replicated in the rest of the world. This is how the adventure of LazyTown begins with the publication of the book "Áfram Latibær", which was later adapted to the theater with record attendance in Iceland. The adaptation for television began in 2002 with the pilot, until it was released in 2004 with the presentation of the show for the North American market. In a short time, LazyTown became a global phenomenon and a benchmark in popular culture.

Since LazyTown came into our lives, the reactions have been positive, whoever has a doubt or does not know what LazyTown teaches can surprise you with a response like this: "LazyTown taught us about friendship, healthy eating, and exercise." It is surprising that one of its episodes was cataloged in a list of the "100 best TV episodes of all time", which makes the series a source of conversation on the internet.



In 1994 & 1995 Scheving was proclaimed continental aerobics champion with his native country.

Sportacus may not have the superpowers of a comic hero like for example those of DC, but the physical attributes of him are typical of a superhuman, example of it is the incredible strength on him. The speed with which he runs too it is most impressive as well the stunts he does.

When we listen to the music of the series, or when we move to the rhythm of their characters as Sportacus, Stephanie and its friends, we feel that we receive superpowers and they help us feel good and in perfect harmony. Maybe it's those super moves that they do that Lazy Town is the favorite series of millions of people in the world who saw it.

This is a tribute to the life of Magnus Scheving: the carpenter, the athlete, the interviewer, the entertainer, the actor, the businessman, the lecturer, the husband, the father, the gentleman, the spy (as a result of his participation in the movie "Spy Next Door" with Jackie Chan), the above-average hero as he describes himself. Who has not dreamed of being a superhero like Sportacus?
